

Nov. 13, 1907. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session, with A.C. Haller, Gus H. Boone, J. C. Walton & the county clerk present.

Bills Claims against the county were examined & allowed as per Allowance Record.

3. Tax cancelled. The Board cancelled 7<sup>30</sup> of the 1907 tax on the following: E. 86<sup>00</sup> of N. 14<sup>00</sup> & N. 55<sup>00</sup> of the N. 74<sup>00</sup> of N. 14<sup>00</sup> less 31<sup>00</sup> to Altenbernd in Sec. 36-12-20, a part of the land having been washed away during "The Flood".

Turner Road. A petition signed by H. C. Turner & 26 others was presented to the Board, praying for the location of a road described as follows: Begin 9<sup>00</sup> rods East of the N. 14<sup>00</sup> cor. of N. 14<sup>00</sup> of Section 7-15-19, thence South 60 rods, thence West 9 rods to public road. Whereupon the Board set Dec. 16, 1907, as the date upon which to meet with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning to view said proposed road and give all parties a proper hearing.

Storber Road, Final. In the matter of C. H. Storber road as petitioned for on Oct. 11, 1905, and viewed Nov. 13, 1905, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the County Surveyor, and that it be established and opened thirty (30) feet in width. The Surveyor's field notes are:— Beginning at the 1/4 corner on the North side of Sec. 1-T. 15-R. 18, thence East fifteen (15) feet, thence South parallel to the quarter section line one mile across Sec. 1, to the South line thereof. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway and instructed the Clerk to so notify the Trustee of Marion Township. The viewers also recommended that the following damages be allowed:— Chas. Hardtgerfer \$20<sup>00</sup>, Ida Simons \$20<sup>00</sup>, Susan Hardtgerfer \$136<sup>00</sup>; and the Board authorized the chairman and Clerk to issue warrants for said amounts to said persons respectively.

Gudd Road, Final. In the matter of the G. Gudd road as petitioned for on April 3, 1907, and viewed on April 29, 1907, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the County Surveyor, and that it be established and opened forty (40) feet in width. The Surveyor's field notes are:— Begin at the N.E. cor. of the S.E. 1/4 of section 18-T. 15-R. 20, thence North to the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe right-of-way, thence N. East along said right-of-way to the South line of section 8-T. 15-R. 20, thence East on Sec. line to the 1/4 sec. corner on the South side of said section 8. The Board declared the above road established as a public highway and instructed the clerk to so notify the Trustee of Palmyra Township. The viewers also recommended the following damages:— Wm.
