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1907. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session, with A. C. Waller, Gus H. Brune, J. C. Walton and the County Clerk present.

Bills. Claims against the county were examined and allowed as per the Allowance Record.

Henshaw Road Final. In the matter of the "Nathan Henshaw Road" as petitioned for April 5, 1907, and viewed May 16, 1907, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the County Surveyor, and that it be established and opened forty feet wide. The Surveyor's Field Notes are:— Begin at the one eight corner on the West line of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 6 - T. 13 - R. 21, thence East 4703 ft., North 245 ft., E. 560 ft. to intersect with 7th St. in Endora Township. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway, and instructed the County Clerk to so notify the trustee of Endora Township. The viewers recommended the following damages on said road:— For Schopper, \$400⁰⁰; Aug. Giesenis, \$85⁰⁰. And the Board authorized its Chairman & Clerk to issue warrants for said amounts in favor of said persons respectively.

Saunders Road Final. In the matter of the "J. C. Saunders Road" as petitioned for April 3, 1907, and viewed April 30, 1907, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the "Field Notes" of the County Surveyor, & that it be established and opened (30) thirty feet in width. The Surveyor's "Field Notes" are:— Begin at the center of Section 36 - T. 12 - R. 20, thence East one half mile to intersect the road along the East line of section 36. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway, and instructed the County Clerk to so notify the trustee of Endora Township. The viewers also recommended that the following damages be allowed:— James M. Davis, \$100⁰⁰; S. C. Gilmore, \$40⁰⁰. And the Board authorized its Chairman and Clerk to issue warrants for said amounts in favor of said persons respectively.
