The following action was taken by the Board:— Whereas one, John Cain, was found guilty of assault & battery at the November term of District Court of Douglas County, I was sentenced to pay a fine of 35⁰⁰ & costs, taxed in the sum of 45⁰⁰; and Whereas said John Cain has been confined in the County jail for more than 60 days, it is hereby ordered by the Board of County Commissioners that so much of the fine as has not been worked out be remitted conditionally upon the said John Cain or some one for him paying the Sheriff of Douglas County the costs of said action, and upon said John Cain deporting himself in the future as a law abiding citizen; Upon payment of said costs, the Sheriff is hereby directed to release the said John Cain from custody upon the conditions hereinbefore mentioned.
