The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kan., met in adjourned regular session. There were present A. C. Waller, Geo. H. Brune, J. C. Walton & the County Clerk.

On Motion the Board authorized & directed the County Treasurer to send twenty eight thousand (28000) dollars of the County General Fund to the Kansas Fiscal Agency at New York City, N.Y. to pay Douglas County bonds that will be due on Jan. 1-1908, said money to be used in that channel only temporarily.

A Resolution providing for the issue of twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28000.00) Refunding Bonds of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas:

Whereas, the county of Douglas in the State of Kansas, has outstanding bonds to the amount of twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28000.00), dated from April 27th 1882 to June 20th 1883, and payable January 1st 1908, bearing interest at the rate of (6%) six per centum per annum, and,
