Skinner
Road.

A petition signed by R. Skinner and 15 others was presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location and vacation of roads as follows:— Locate: Begin 80 rods North and about 40 rods East of S.W. cor. of Sec. 20 - T. 12 - R. 19, thence in a N. Easterly direction to N. & S. road about 40 rods North of center of said S.E. 4. Also begin in N. & S. road about 60 rods N. of center of said S.E. 4, thence North as near as practicable for a good road to intersect E. & W. road which runs through the southern part of the N.E. 4 of said Sec. 20. Vacate:— All parts of the old road which will be supplied by the new road. Whereupon the Board decided to meet with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the 31st day of January, 1908, to view said road and give all interested parties a proper hearing.
