

The following was unanimously passed by the Board of Commissioners:  
 Whereas, On this the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1908, a petition was presented  
 to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, from the City of  
 Lawrence, asking said Board of County Commissioners to make a finding  
 as to the advisability of adding the following territory to the said City, to wit:

Beginning at a point where the West line of Mississippi Street intersects  
 with the South line of Lee Street in the City of Lawrence, in said  
 county & state, thence West two hundred fifty (250) ft., thence North to the  
 city limits, thence East two hundred fifty (250) ft. to the West line of Mississippi  
 Street, thence South along the West line of Mississippi Street to the place of beginning;

And Whereas, the said City of Lawrence has caused due notice to be  
 published for three consecutive weeks in the Lawrence Journal, a weekly  
 news-paper, which said news-paper is published and ~~is~~ of general circulation  
 in said city, that said petition will be presented to the said Board of  
 County Commissioners at their office in the Court House, in the City of  
 Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1908;

Now therefore, said hearing having been had on this the 5<sup>th</sup> day  
 of February, 1908, and said petition and notice of said hearing having  
 been legally published as provided by law, and said Board of County  
 Commissioners being fully advised in the premises, do find, that it is  
 advisable that this territory, to wit;

Beginning at a point where the West line of Mississippi Street  
 intersects with the South line of Lee Street in the City of Lawrence, in  
 said County & state, thence West two hundred fifty (250) ft., thence North  
 to the City Limits, thence East two hundred fifty (250) ft. to the West line of  
 Mississippi Street, thence South along the West line of Mississippi Street  
 to the place of beginning,

should be added to the said City of Lawrence, and that  
 it will be to the interests of said city, and will cause no manifest  
 injury to the persons owning the real-estate in said territory  
 to be added.

Board adjourned to meet Feb. 8, 1908.
