Feb. 10, 1908. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with Gus H. Brune, J. C. Walton, A. C. Waller & the county clerk present.

Bills Claims against the county were examined and allowed as per Allowance Record.

Skinner Road In the matter of the R. Skinner road as petitioned for on Jan. 6, 1908, & viewed Jan. 31, 1908, the Board accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located ^{30 ft. wide} according to the field notes of the County Surveyor, and that the vacations asked for be granted. The field notes of the Surveyor are: ^{Locality} Begin 160 ft. North ² 15 ft. West of the ¹ & cor. on the North line of the S.E. ¹ of Sec. 20-12-19, thence S. 160 ft. to a point 15 ft. N. of the above mentioned ¹ & cor., S. 153 ft., S. 62° 35' N. 67 ft., S. 35° N. 97 ft., S. 11° 22' E. 200 ft., S. 32° 30' E. 151 ft., S. 315 ft., S. 56° N. 277 ft., S. 72° N. 200 ft., S. 51° 30' N. 314 ft. vacate: all portions of the old road which are supplied by the new road. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway thirty feet wide, & instructed the county clerk to so notify the trustee of Kanawaka Township. The viewers also recommended that Mrs. Mary B. Peterson be allowed (\$50.00) fifty dollars as damages. The Board authorized its Chairman and Clerk to issue a county warrant in favor of Mrs. Mary B. Peterson for the sum of fifty dollars for said damages.
