The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. There were present Gus H. Brune, J. C. Walton, A. C. Walter and the County Clerk.

Bills

Claims against the county were examined and allowed as per allowance Record.

The following notice in reference to the construction of four bridges was ordered printed in the Official Paper:-

Lawrence, Kansas, May 13-1908.

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, until 12 o'clock M. June 6, 1908, for the construction of four bridges of the following sizes, to wit: One bridge of (140) one hundred and forty feet span, and fourteen (14) foot roadway. Two bridges of one hundred and twenty (120) feet span, and fourteen (14) foot roadway, and one sixty (60) feet span, with fourteen (14) foot roadway. The 140 foot span & the two 120 foot spans to have concrete filled tubes for foundation, Superstructure only, for the 60 foot span. The 60 foot span to have two tubes forty two feet long & two tubes 37 feet long. The 120 foot spans to have 8 tubes forty feet long. All tubes to be 42 inches in diameter. Each tube to rest on three piles, driven to solid foundation. Piles to be at least ten inches in diameter at the small end. All bridges to be designed to carry a live load of 80 lbs. per square foot of floor surface.

Bidders are requested to bid on both plank & concrete floors. All bridges to have steel joints.

Bidders will submit plans showing the sizes & kinds of materials to be used. All plans to be accompanied by strain sheets.

Profiles of the bridge sites are on file at the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas.

Bids must be accompanied by certified checks for fifty dollars for each and every span.

The right is reserved to reject any and all bids.
