The above described strip or parcel of land is hereby dedicated to Douglas County, State of Kansas, to be used as a public highway. Treasury Examiners
E. G. Steele Road Final.
In the matter of E. G. Steele Road as petitioned for Feb. 5-1908 & viewed on March. 5-1908, The Board of County Commissioners accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located and opened forty feet in width according to the field notes of the County Surveyor. The Surveyor's field notes are:— Begin at a point on line and 2335 ft. N. of the center corner of Sec. 25-T. 13-R. 17, th. East 2335 ft. to the center of said section 25, th. East 20 feet, th. North parallel to & Sec. line 2045 feet, th. N. 78° 21' E. 208 ft., th. N. 64° 30' E. 236 feet, th. N. 38° 14' E. 210 feet, th. N. 15° 35' E. 300 feet, th. E. on line to N.E. cor. of said Sec. 25, th. S. 20 ft., th. E. parallel to & 20 ft. S. of Sec. line between sections 19 & 30 of T. 13-R. 18 to Harkness Creek, th. N. 40 ft., th. E. parallel to and 20 ft. N. of line between sections 19 & 30 to the E. line of Sec. 19, th. E. 7 ft., th. N. parallel to and 7 ft. E. of E. line of said Sec. 19 one hundred thirty rods more or less to intersect a county road. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway, and instructed the clerk to so notify the Trustee of Clinton Township. The viewers also recommended the following damages:— J. H. Hallmark \$50.00, John Benard \$100.00; as chairmen, Ed Steele \$20.00 & Wm. Housworth \$20.00. The Board authorized the chairman and clerk to issue warrants for the above amounts to said persons respectively.
