

Aug. 12, 1908. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with Gus H. Brune, J. C. Kallon, A. C. Katter and the County Clerk present.

Bills Claims against the County were examined and allowed as per "allowance record".

Road The Herbert Bracheisen Road hearing was postponed to September the 9, 1908.

Jail The Board located the site for the erection of the new jail & jailer's residence.

Notice to Contractors.

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, at the office of the County Clerk in the Court House in the city of Lawrence until 12 o'clock M. of Monday the 14th day of Sept., 1908, for special jail work in the building of a county county jail & Sheriff's residence in said city of Lawrence, according to plans & specifications now on file in the office of said County Clerk.

Said special jail work includes cells, jail doors, window guards, locking devices, etc.

Only general plans for cell work have been adopted, and bidders are at liberty to submit specifications with their proposals, but the same general conditions shall govern this special work as govern the building contract.

The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to file bonds as required by law, to be approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

Each proposal must be accompanied by an unconditional certified check on some bank in the City of Lawrence payable to the Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, in the sum of one hundred fifty (\$150) dollars.

The checks of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned at the close of the letting.

The check of the successful bidder shall be forfeited to Douglas County if such bidder shall fail or refuse to enter into contract and file approved bonds within ten days, but, if within this time he enters into contract & files such bond, then his check is to be immediately returned to him.

The plans & specifications above referred to are to be at all times in the possession of the County Clerk and are not to leave said office until said contract is let.

Bidders will seal their proposals, address them to the Board of County Commissioners, and file with the County Clerk by 12 o'clock M. Monday, the 14th day of Sept., 1908, as no bids after that time will be considered.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
