Dedication

The Board accepted the following Road Dedication:—Begin 107 rods West and 20 ft. South of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner on East side of section 10-7-12 & 19 East, thence South 7 Rods, E. $2\frac{83}{100}$ Rods, North 7 Rods, West $2\frac{83}{100}$ Rods to begin, containing $\frac{1}{8}$ of an acre.

North Side
Drainage
District
Petition

The Board appointed Chas. Haas & Chas. Rappard as Treasury Examiners for the quarter ending Sept. 30, 1908.

A petition signed by residents of North Lawrence & Grant Township was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for permission to organize a Drainage District, said district to consist of the following described lands:—Beginning at a point on the South bank of the Kansas River directly opposite the boundary line between Grant Township, Douglas County, Kansas, & Jefferson County, Kansas; thence in a straight line across said river to a point where the said boundary line between Grant Township and Jefferson County touches the North bank of the Kansas river; thence East on said county line to Mud Creek; thence in a Southeasterly direction, following the South bank of Mud Creek, to a point where said Mud Creek intersects the boundary line between Grant Township, Douglas County, Kansas, and Leavenworth County, Kansas; thence South on said boundary line between Grant Township & Leavenworth County, Kansas, to a point where said boundary line touches the North bank of the Kansas River; thence South across said Kansas river to a point on the South bank of said river directly opposite the said boundary line between Grant Township & Leavenworth County, Kansas; thence along the South bank of said Kansas river, following the meanderings of said stream, in a general Westerly & Northerly direction to the place of beginning — Whereupon the Board set Sept. 24, 1908, at 10 o'clock A.M. as the date to hear the arguments on said petition.

Board adjourned to meet Sept. 19, 1908.
