

The construction of levees, drains and other works are necessary to prevent such overflow, and such improvement will be conducive to the public welfare.

That said petition is in conformity to the requirements of the law as found in chapter 215 of the session laws of Kansas for the year 1905; & that all the allegations of said petition are true.

And the Board of County Commissioners doth here now, declare the territory described in said petition and map thereto attached, to wit: All that portion of Grant Township, Douglas County, Kansas, embraced within the boundary lines described as follows:—Beginning at the N.W. cor. of the N.W. of Section 6—S. 12 South—R. 20 East; thence running E. to the N.E. cor. of said $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.; S. to S.E. cor. of said $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.; S.E. to S.E. cor. of ~~S.W.~~ of said Sec. 6; E. to the S.E. cor. of S.W. of Sec. 5; S. to S.E. cor. of N.W. of Sec. 8; E. to N.E. cor. of N.W. of S.E. of said Sec. 8; S. to S. line of said Sec. 8; West to S.W. cor. of S.E. of S.W. of said Sec. 8; due N.W. to N.W. cor. of S.W. of S.W. of said Sec. 8; N. to S.E. cor. of N.E. of N.E. of S.E. of Sec. 7; N. to S.W. cor. of N.W. of N.W. of S.E. of Sec. 7; N. to S.E. cor. of N.W. of said Sec. 7; N.W. to N.W. cor. of said Sec. 7; thence N. to N.W. cor. of said Sec. 6 to point of beginning;

To constitute a Public Corporation, and the inhabitants within such bounds are hereby incorporated as a Drainage District under the name of "The Mud Creek Drainage District, Douglas County, Kansas."

And it is further ordered by the Board, that the time and place of holding the first election to choose officers for such Drainage District be set and fixed as follows, to wit: On the 5th day of Nov., 1905, between the hours of 8 A.M. & 6 P.M. at the house of Ernest H. Young, situated within said Drainage District in the said Grant Township, Douglas County, Kansas,

And the following resident taxpayers residing within said Drainage District are hereby designated to act as Judges and Clerks at said Election, to wit: For Judges S.M. Dolan, A.H. Garvin & F.J. Savage, and for Clerks R.J. Eastman & Ernest H. Young.

The County Clerk is hereby directed to cause notice of said election to be published in the Official County paper.
