Oct. 22, 1908. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session. There were present Gus H. Brune, J. C. Walton, A. C. Walter and the County Clerk.

A petition signed by O. G. Pedersen and 12 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows: Beginning at a point at the N.E. cor. of Sec. 5 - T. 12 - R. 20, and running from that point east along the North line of Sec. 4 - T. 12 - R. 20 forty one (41) rods to the Lawrence road at that point on the County line. Whereupon the Board agreed to meet in conjunction with the county Surveyor and the viewors who may be appointed by the Jefferson County Board as this is a county line road between Douglas & Jefferson Counties on Nov. 18 - 1908, at the place of Beginning, to view said proposed road and give all parties a proper hearing. The Board instructed the County Clerk to notify the Board of Jefferson County of the above action.

In the matter of the petition of W. A. Spray and nine others, to form a Drainage District, as petitioned for on Oct. 14, 1908.

And now on this 22nd day of October, 1908, came the above named W. A. Spray and nine other parties who signed the petition filed Oct. 8, 1908, and thereupon said petition came regularly on for hearing before the Board of County Commissioners, this being the day set for such hearing in the order made Oct. 14, 1908.

And the Board upon the examination of the proof of publication in this matter, this day filed, do find that notice has been given of the time of the hearing of said petition, as heretofore ordered by this Board, and as required by law; and thereupon the Board proceeded to hear all persons in favor of, or opposed to granting the prayer of said petition, and all other evidence offered for the purpose of ascertaining whether said petition contained the proper number of signatures possessing the qualifications prescribed by law, and whether the statements of said petition are true:
