We will place this boiler complete for the sum of one hundred (100) dollars, but it is understood that we are to leave out the specified connections to the original specified tunnel and connections to steam boiler in court-house. The above proposal contemplates the necessary changing of steam mains to accomodate the placing of the boiler. In case you decide to burn gas in this boiler, we will place "Perfection" Natural Gas Burners in the same connecting it up complete for the sum of twenty five (25<sup>00</sup>) dollars.
