Greenwood Valley Bridge In the matter of Bids on the erection of Stone Arch Bridge at Greenwood valley, which bids were opened Nov. 10-1908, the Board awarded the work to O. E. Baughman at fifteen cents per foot. The different bids were J. H. Gray, 20¢ per foot; O. E. Baughman 15¢ per foot; J. E. Shaffer 25¢ per foot and 50¢ per yd for first 24 yds. & 25¢ for each additional yard.

J. F. Pine Road Final. In the matter of J. F. Pine road as petitioned for Sept. 12-1908, and viewed Oct. 15-1908, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the County Surveyor. The Surveyor's field notes are: Beginning at a point on the section line, 676 1/2 ft. N. of the 4 section corner between sections 18 & 19 of T. 12 - R. 20; thence N. 16° 30' N. 492 ft.; thence N. 39° 25' N. 805 ft. to a point on public road levee. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway eighty feet wide, and instructed the County Clerk to so notify the trustee of Grant Township. The viewers recommended that H. N. Cockins be allowed five hundred (500.00) dollars damage, and the Board, authorized the Chairman and Clerk to issue a warrant in favor of H. N. Cockins for five hundred (500.00) dollars for said damages.
