Bridges. The Board contracted with the Mo. Valley Bridge & Iron Works for the approaches to the three Wakarusa Bridges now being built by said Co. at fourteen (14<sup>00</sup>) dollars per running foot, the wall at Halmark Bridge included. The East approach to the Eudora bridge, not included with the above, is to be 20 ft. long, and is to be constructed for the sum of one hundred seventy two (172<sup>00</sup>) dollars, the County furnishing three piling at Lawrence.
