Petition

A petition signed by H. H. Hare & others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying that all the land and territory here-in-after described be incorporated into a Drainage District to be known as the "Number Four Drainage District of Douglas County, Kan.," To wit:— Begin at the S.W. cor. of Sec. 12 - T. 12 - R. 19; thence East 80 rods; South 120 R.; East 80 R.; South to center of Sec. 13; East to center of Sec. 18; North to center of Sec. 7, N.W. on a straight line to the N.W. corner of Sec. 7; South 80 R.; West 160 R.; South to center of Sec. 12; South 18 $\frac{2}{3}$ R.; West 160 R.; South to place of beginning, the S.W. cor. of Sec. 12. — Whereupon the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, agreed to hear said petition at the Court-house on the 31st day of December, 1908, at 10 o'clock A.M.

A petition signed by A. J. Wood & others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying that all the land and territory here-in-after mentioned be incorporated into a Drainage District to be known as "The North Side Drainage District of Douglas County, Kansas," To wit:— Begin at a point on the south bank of the Kansas River at low water mark midway between the North & South boundary
