The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session, with Gus H. Brune, J. C. Walton, A. C. Walter and the County Clerk present.

The Board cancelled \$5²⁶ of the 1908 personal tax of D. L. Thomas, in Lawrence; the above being the tax on National Bank Stock which is assessed in the State of Kentucky.

The Board cancelled \$8¹⁴ of the 1908 tax on S. E. of Sec. 14-15-19, the assessor making oath that he erred in copying the valuation.

In the matter of the John Connole road as petitioned for Sept. 8-1908, and viewed Sept. 30-1908, the Board accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the county surveyor, forty feet wide. The field Notes are: Begin at the point where the public road crosses the line between Sections 19 & 20-T. 13-R. 18; thence North on line to the N. E. corner of Sec. 19; West 20 ft.; North parallel to and 20 feet West of the East line of Sec. 18-T. 13-R. 18 one half mile to intersect public road. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway, and instructed the Clerk to so notify the Trustee of Clinton Township. The viewers recommended the following damages: Isaac Humphrey \$175⁰⁰, Mrs. Isabella C. Steele \$80⁰⁰. The Board authorized the Chairman & Clerk to issue warrants to the above named parties for the said amounts.
