Whereas, the said Board has duly and carefully investigated said matter and upon said investigation find that each member of the Board and the County Clerk of said County denied that they or either of them ever made such statement or ever made any statement that would be subject to such construction. and

Whereas, all bills of said Poor Commissioner have passed through the hands of said Board of County Commissioners and have been at all times by said Board carefully examined and audited, they are fully satisfied that the accounts of said Poor Commissioner "are not crooked" and have at all times been correct in amount.

The Board therefore finds that it is unnecessary to have an investigation of the same.
