Aug. 9th 1909. A petition was filed by J. E. Hutt for the vacation of Learnard Place, an addition to the City of Lawrence.

The Proof of Publication of said petition was filed in this office Oct. 2nd 1909.

J. D. Brooks, City Clerk, filed a certificate stating that said petition was presented to the Mayor and Council of the City of Lawrence and that the prayer of said petitioner was granted. The Mayor and City Council recommended to the Board of County Commissioners that said petition to vacate be also granted.

The following action was taken by the Board of County Commissioners.

Now on this 5th day of October, 1909, at the regular October session of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, the petition of J. E. Hutt to vacate certain described lands and drives called "Learnard Place" an addition to the City of Lawrence, according to the plat filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County on November 25, 1901, which addition is described as follows to-wit: - Beginning at the north east corner of Lot 7, in Block 5, in Babcocks Addition to the City of Lawrence, thence west on the north boundary line of said Lot 7 and its continuation 640 feet more or less to the west boundary line of section 6, Township 13, Range 29, East of the 6th P.M., thence south on said line of section 6,
