From Henry Street south on Mississippi Street to a point two hundred feet south of Quincy Street, thence south on the parking west of the street roadway to the grounds of the University of Kansas; thence in a southward and westward direction to the top of the University hill, to connect with a line on the south side of the University hill at a point near the intersection of Ontario and Louisiana Streets, provided that permission to construct said line through the grounds of said University be properly and legally granted by the Board of Regents of said University;

That permission to construct its said line of street railway through the grounds of the University of Kansas has been properly and legally granted by the Board of Regents of said University, and in order that the said petitioner may comply with the above provisions of said Ordinance No. 413, and connect its line on Ontario Street with its line to be constructed through the grounds of the University of Kansas, it is necessary that it have the right to construct its line of street railway over, along and across a certain county highway, a more particular description of which is as follows:-

The county road the center line of which is a line forty (40) rods south of and parallel to the north line of the north-east quarter of section One (1) of Township Thirteen (13) south and range Nineteen (19) east of the 6th Principal Meridian, in Douglas County, Kansas; at a point about six Hundred and Ninety eight (698) feet west of the east line of said quarter section;

That the said road is wholly outside the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and is a county road and highway, duly dedicated to the use of the public.

Wherefore, the said petitioner asks and requests that consent, permission and authority be given to it, said petitioner, The Lawrence Railway & Light Company, its successors and assigns, to construct, maintain and operate a line of street railway over, along and across the portion of the said county road and highway hereinabove described, together with the right to construct and maintain such poles, wires and mechanical appliances as may be reasonably necessary and proper for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating said line of street railway.
