

and that he has paid out of said funds to parties entitled thereto the sum of \$158.85, leaving a balance now in his hands belonging to said County Court of \$179.55.

And he asks for an order of the said Board to pay over said sum of \$179.55 to the County Treasurer of said County. Upon consideration whereof and said Board being fully advised in the premises and finding that the statements in said petition are true, It is ordered by the Board of County Commissioners that said Henry H. Asher, be authorized and directed to pay said sum of \$179.55 into the General Fund of said County and take his duplicate receipts therefor in the manner provided by law.

It is further ordered by the Board that upon so doing said Henry H. Asher, shall be relieved and discharged from any further liability on account of said funds, in so far as the disposition of said fund is concerned.
