The Board ordered the following notice to be printed in the official paper.
Notice to Contractors.

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, at the office of the County Clerk in the Court house in the City of Lawrence until 12 M. noon Saturday the 11th day of June, 1910 for work and materials in the building of a County Hospital Building for the poor in said County, according to plans and specifications prepared by Hellman & Blair, Architects, now on file in the office of said County Clerk, and at office of Architects.

Separate bids will be received for plumbing, heating, electric wiring, and gas fitting as one contract. The remaining work to be let to general contractor. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to file bonds as required by law, to be approved by the board of county commissioners.

Each proposal must be accompanied by an unconditional certified check on some bank in the City of Lawrence, payable to the Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, in the sum of 2 1/2 per cent of the bid. The checks of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned at the close of the letting. The check of the successful bidder shall be forfeited to Douglas County if such bidder shall fail to refuse to enter into contract and file approved bonds within ten days, but if within this time he enters into contract and files such bond, then that check is to be immediately returned to him.

Bidders will seal their proposals, address them to the board of County Commissioners, and file with the County Clerk by 12 o'clock noon Saturday, the 11th day of June, 1910, as no bids after that time will be considered.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
