June 9-10- The Board of County Commissioners met in Regular Session. All present. Claims against the County were examined and allowed as per Allowance Record. The Board met as a Board of Equalization for Marion Township.

Before the Board of County Commissioners in and for Douglas County, Kansas, comes now James E. Stubbs and shows to the Honorable Board, that on the 4th day of October, 1909, at the Regular October Session of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, an order was duly made vacating the streets and alleys of the east half of the north east quarter of the south east quarter of the south west quarter of section 36, Township 18, Range 19 east of the 6th P.M. Douglas County, Kansas, as shown by the recorded plat called University Heights.

That in said order, the range wherein said land is located, was erroneously described as range 27 east of the 6th P.M., when in truth and in fact it should have been described as Range 19 east of the 6th P.M. That no such range exists as Range 27 east of the 6th P.M. in Douglas County, Kansas.

Your petitioner therefore, asks that the Honorable Board, make an order correcting the erroneous description made by it on the 4th day of October, 1909, to the correct description, to-wit: Range 19 east of the 6th P.M.

And this Board doth find that in the order heretofore made by it on the 4th day of October, 1909, vacating the streets and alleys in that portion of the east half of the north east quarter of the south east quarter of the south west quarter of section 36, Township 18, Range 19 east of the 6th P.M. Douglas County, Kansas, the range wherein said land is located was erroneously described in said order as being in Range 27 east of the 6th P.M. when in truth and in fact said land was located in and should have been described as being in Range 19 east of the 6th P.M.
