 The bid of Kennedy Plumbing Co. to do the plumbing, gasfitting, electric wiring & steam heating in the Co. Hospital for the Poor was \$183.55
 Gruber Bros. bid to do the plumbing etc. in the Co. Hospital for \$980.⁰⁰
 John H. Petty bid to do the " " " " " for \$676.⁵⁰
 Geo. H. Savage bid to do the " " " " " for \$962.¹⁸
 The bid of John H. Petty to build the Co. Hospital Bldg. for the Poor being the lowest was accepted by the Board.
 The bid of Geo. H. Savage to do the plumbing, etc. was accepted by the Board - his bid being the lowest.
