

Aug. 20-1910 - The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session, A. C. Walter, J. L. Mc Clelland, J. C. Walton and County Clerk present.

The following resolution was duly adopted -

Whereas on the 17th day of November 1904, the then County Clerk of the County illegally assessed personal property belonging to the estate of Lemay Green, deceased, said illegal tax and penalties amount to \$105.13 and whereas - thereafter the then County Treasurer of said County on the 13th day of May 1910 caused a tax warrant to be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the District Court as provided by law.

Now therefore by reason of said tax being illegal the County Attorney is hereby directed to release said said tax on the record in the Office of the Clerk of the District Court -

The Board approved the Bond of E. H. Armstrong as Treasurer of Wakarusa Twp. The Board approved the Bond of John H. Petty. The following is the contract between John H. Petty and the Board of County Commissioners.

Contract -

This agreement made and entered into this 23rd day of July, 1910, by and between John H. Petty of Paola, Kansas, party of the first part, and Albert Walter, J. C. Walton, J. L. Mc Clelland, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, for and on behalf of said County, party of the second part, -

Witnesseth: That said party of the first part for the consideration hereinafter mentioned, covenants, and agrees to make, erect, build and finish in a good, substantial and workman-like manner, and in conformity with the plans, drafts and specifications and explanations made by H. T. Wellman and Albert E. Blair, which is herewith annexed and made a part hereof, a hospital building for the poor on the county farm, Douglas County, Kansas, on or before the 1st day of January 1911: - That said work shall be done under the direction and to the satisfaction of the said Architects or such other Architects in good standing, as said party of the second part shall select for that purpose, to be testified to by a certificate of writing under the hand of the said Architects. That said building shall be made, erected and built out of good and substantial material, and that as soon as the roof thereon is put on and covered, said party of the first part shall effect full insurance on said building, the policy or policies to be made payable to the parties hereto as their interests may appear. In consideration, of which, said party of the second part does hereby covenant, promise and agree, to pay, or cause to be paid, unto the said party of the first part, or their legal representatives, the sum of Twenty Two thousand nine hundred forty-four (\$22,944) dollars, in the manner following, to-wit: - Ninety per cent of the value of labor
