The following notice was published in the Lawrence Daily Journal-
 World, July 5, -1911: -

To the Voters of Douglas County, Kansas: -

You will please take notice that on this, the 5th day of July, 1911,
 at the regular July session of the Board of County Commissioners,
 a resolution was passed by said Board of County Commissioners
 appropriating about fifteen thousand dollars (\$15000.00) for the
 building and repairing of bridges in Douglas County, Kansas, as
 follows, to-wit: In Leecompton township, Douglas County, Kansas,
 for the repairing of bridges \$50.00; in Kanwaka Township, for
 the repairing of bridges, \$4,000.00; in Clinton township, for the
 repairing of bridges, 1,057.00; in Marion Township, for the repairing
 of bridges, \$1,690.00; in Willow Springs Township, for the construction
 of one new bridge and for the repairing of bridges, \$2,500.00;
 in Palmyra Township, for the construction of one new bridge
 and for the repairing of bridges, \$2,250.00; in Eudora Township,
 for the repairing of bridges, \$1,357.00; in Grant Township, for the
 repairing of bridges, \$1,125.00; in Wakarusa Township, for the
 repairing of bridges, \$2,466.00.

And said appropriation will be made by the Board of
 County Commissioners without submitting such proposition to
 the voters of Douglas County, Kansas, unless within thirty
 (30) days from this date a petition signed by ten percent
 of the legal voters of Douglas County, Kansas, shall be presented
 to the Board of County Commissioners requesting that the
