General Electric transformer to be furnished and installed near said building, and secondary lines to be run to said building; also secondary line to run to Pump House on said premises approximately 500' from said Main Building. One 2200 volt, 60 cycle, single phase watt hour meter to be furnished and installed where this transmission line connects with the Lawrence Railway and Light Company's lines at Bishop and Barker Avenues in the City of Lawrence. Material furnished to be first class and work to be done in a good and workmanlike manner. Said line to be completed within thirty (30) days from the date hereof, accidents and unavoidable conditions and casualties excepted.

In consideration whereof, the said party of the first part, agrees to pay said party of the second part the sum of \$1800.00, payments to be made weekly, that is, on Saturday of each week during the construction of said work, on estimates made in writing by the County Surveyor of Douglas County, Kansas. Ten per cent (10%) of the amount of such estimates to be retained until the work shall be completed and accepted by the Board of County Commissioners, when the balance remaining due shall be promptly paid.

This agreement shall be binding upon the successors of the said party of the first part, and upon the heirs and legal representatives of the party of the second part.

In witness whereof, the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has caused this contract to be signed by its Chairman, thereunto duly authorized, and to be attested by the County Clerk of said County and has caused the seal of said County to be hereto affixed; and the said J.
