The Board rejected the bills of the Douglas County Fair and Agricultural Society and the Fairland Grange Fair Association upon the following recommendation from the County Atty. Board of County Commissioners, Douglas County, Kansas, Gentlemen:-

The bill of seven hundred and thirty six dollars and five cents (\$736.05) presented by the Douglas County Fair and Agricultural Society, a Corporation, to you for allowance, I have carefully investigated, and have looked up the law in this matter.

From my investigation of the law in the matter, I have come to the conclusion that this bill should not be paid by the County. In the first place, the law is ambiguous, and in the second place, I am of the opinion that it is invalid. I have come to this conclusion, gentlemen, after a very careful investigation.

I make the same recommendation in regard to the bill presented by the Fairland Grange Fair Association.
