

Jan. 10-12- The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session. A. C. Walter, J. C. Walton, Gus H. Brunel and Dep. Clerk were present. Claims against the County were examined and allowed as per Allowance Record.

The Board approved the Depository Bonds of the Lawrence Natl. Bank and the Watkins Natl. Bank. Also approved the Bond of The Lawrence Railway and Light Company.

The Board appropriated \$435⁰⁰ to J. H. Kreider for lumber for the Reampton Bridge.

The Board rejected the bill of A. F. Kennedy for \$5⁰⁰ for burying dead horse near West Baldwin in Palmyra Twp., said bill was filed Aug. 31st 1911.

A. C. Walter resigned as Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and J. C. Walton was appointed Chairman for the ensuing year.

S. J. Gillispie was appointed Health Officer for the year 1912.

Henry Gillum was appointed janitor for the ensuing year.

The Gazette was made the official paper for the year 1912.

The Board adjourned to meet Jan. 17th.

Jan. 27-12- The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. J. C. Walton, A. C. Walter, Gus H. Brunel were present.

The Board cancelled to D. B. Rogers all of his personal property tax for 1911 except \$1⁶⁵ as he was given no exemption.

The Board cancelled to Emma A. Hoyer \$0⁵⁰ of her P.P. tax for 1911 \$700⁰⁰ of it being Bank stock and not taxable.

The Board cancelled to Mrs M. Ingram \$3⁰⁰ of her P.P. tax for 1911 as she was given no exemption.

The Board cancelled to P. Leslie the P.P. tax of 1911 on all but \$30⁰⁰ on account of double assessment.

The Board cancelled to R. H. Baldwin \$3⁰⁰ of his P.P. tax for 1911 as he was given no exemption.

The Board cancelled to E. A. Smith the penalties, interest & costs on his special tax of 1910 on 6th of S. 1117th of Reserve & allowed him to redeem same for original amount of tax \$35⁶³ on account of error in overlooking same by former Co. Treasurer.

The Board cancelled to Geo. Sternburg all of his P.P. tax for 1911 as he was erroneously assessed.
