In regard to repairing the abutment of the Belvoir bridge, I have the honor to report that I consider it to be necessary to make the repairs immediately. The abutment is in such a condition that the delay necessary to advertise for the work might cause the loss of the span. I would therefore recommend that the work be done without advertising.
