Your petitioner further states that she has lost the use of both eyes, that she is totally blind and has been in such condition since she was seven years old; that she is now and has been living with her father and mother, but that they are not financially capable of caring for her; that she desires to fit herself to teach music so that she may earn her own way, but that she has used all the means in her power and at her command to accomplish that end, and that it is necessary that she take further instruction.
