The Board allowed E. E. Whitman road as petitioned for on Aug. 7th-1911- The Viewers recommended the road established as a public highway on half sec. line in Marion Township, beginning 70 rods north of south east corner of south west quarter of sec. 12 Twp. 14 Rg. 18 following half sec. line, North 140 rods th. East 80 rods, North east 30 rods to connect with main road. Said road to be 40 feet in width. The Board instructed the County Clerk to notify the Trustee of Marion Township that said road be established according to above notes. The Viewers recommended that \$200.00 damages be allowed J. D. Hoover & instructed the Co. Clerk to issue a warrant for the same.

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
