*Bills* The Board met in adjourned regular session with all members present. Claims against the county were examined and allowed as per Allowance Record.

The following refunds were made: Mrs. Mary E. Kelly, \$11.30, erroneous assessment taxed 9 acres, and had paid the half year tax on it of \$15.40. Mrs. Kelly has land 65 ft. by 313½ ft. in 6-13-20.

*Refunds* Mrs. Mary L. Emery was refunded the amount of \$41 on account of erroneous assessment, being put in the wrong school district.

U. S. G. Plank was refunded the amount of \$121.40 erroneous assessment on the Phi Beta Pi House and the Chi Omega House - these houses are exempt from taxation being fraternity houses.

A refund of \$22.42 was made to S. D. Wise, erroneous assessment - the land cannot be found.

Jesse Pieratt, Superintendent of the County Home from April 1, 1913 to April 1, 1914.

The Board entered into the following Road Dragging Contracts:

With C. B. Rumsey and J. C. Rumsey to drag the county roads described as follows:

Begin at NE cor. 32-13-20; th. follow Lawrence and Vinland road to Vinland at NE cor. 16-14-20; th. S½ miles to ¼ cor. between secs. 21 & 22 in 14-20.

With G. T. Dunigan to drag the county roads described as follows:

*Road Dragging Contracts* Begin at S end of Vt. St., Lawrence; th. W to NW cor. 12-13-19; th. S across Dutton Bridge; th. W to bridge across Washington Creek.

With Fred Wulfkuhle to drag the county roads described as follows:

Begin at SE cor. of 29-12-18; th. W 3½ miles; th. N 1 mile; th. W ½ miles to County Line.

With L. M. Walter to drag the county roads described as follows:

Begin at NE cor. 3-13-20; th. follow County Road W to Lawrence at W side of 32-12-20.

With John Moody to drag the county roads described as follows:

Begin at NE cor. of 3-13-20; th. E along County Road follow Golden Belt Road to the Wakarusa Bridge at Eudora.
