With C. W. Flory to furnish all labor and power required to drag the county roads described as follows:

Begin at the NE cor. of Marion Twp. and follow county road as laid out to Marion Twp. Hall.

With J. J. Tabler to furnish all labor and power required to drag the county roads described as follows:

Begin at Washington Creek Bridge east of Model School House, thence west to Johnson's cor., th. east line of Sec. 23, Twp. 13, Range 18.

With Martin Rohe, Jr. to furnish all labor and power required to drag the county roads described as follows:

Begin at the NE cor. of 6-15-21, th. N. three miles, th. E. one mile, th. N. one mile to Palmyra Township Line.
