Begin at the railroad on center line of 4-15-20, th. W. to section line th. N. one half mile, th. W. on section line one and one half miles to center line of sec. 6, twp. 15, range 20 - two miles and one quarter in length.

With C. C. Waters to furnish all labor and power required to drag the county roads described as follows:

Begin at the NE cor. sec. 6, twp. 15, range 21, south one mile, east three miles to county line.

W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 2 twp. 12, range 18, which is 3393 feet west of the quarter cor. stone on the east line of said section 2; thence north 363 ft., thence in a westerly direction in line with a point on the west line and 319 ft. north of the southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 2, twp. 12, range 18, a distance of 1558 ft.; thence angle to right 49° 45', a distance of 52.3 ft., thence angle to left 49° 8'; a distance of 335 ft. to intersect road on west line of sec. 2, twp. 12, range 18,
