It is therefore agreed by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the repairs, to wit: repairs of the stringers and floors of the Lecompton Bridge be made, and that the costs and expenses of the same shall be paid in equal shares by the said respective counties of Jefferson and Douglas.

It is agreed on the part of the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that as soon as the work of the repairs is completed, that the said Douglas County Board shall notify the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County Kansas, and that said Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas may proceed to inspect the work and if acceptable to such Jefferson County Board that immediate payment shall be made by the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas for its equal share of the expense and cost of such repair.
