Begin at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. on south side of sec. 21, twp. 14, range 19, th. W  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles, th. S 2 miles to Worden, also begin 1 mile West of Worden and extending East  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles.

The Board entered into a contract with S. J. Lawson to furnish all labor and power required to drag the county roads described as follows:

Begin at the east line of the city of Eudora, th. east on county road one mile to school house #30, th. south  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile, th. east 1 mile to county line.
