The Board ordered the Co. Clerk to make the following changes in the 1913 assessment:-

Carrie Place, Lot 93 Fremont st City of Baldwin valuation reduced from \$1150<sup>00</sup> to \$50<sup>00</sup> on account of fact there were no improvements on said lot as assessed.

Geo Foster, F. F. tax Baldwin City valuation of \$3500<sup>00</sup> Real Estate Contract stricken from his assessment.

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W H Smith appeared personally before the Board and requested that a Bond for Deed be stricken off the tax list, which the Board could not grant.

A Crysler of Baldwin City claimed \$2500<sup>00</sup> valuation on Improvements too high because house was unfinished. Board instructed Dep assessor J L Wise to investigate the matter and report to Co. Assessor Armstrong.
