The Board ordered Co. Clerk to advertise for bids for repairing the above bridge as follows:

Clerk's office at Lawrence Kan. until 12 O'clock noon on Saturday June 21st, 1913 for furnishing steel joints and Steel railing for a 50 ft bridge, 3 1/2 miles S. W. of Baldwin Kan. The Contractor to furnish material and labor necessary to put steel in place on the bridge and relay the floor and paint the steel work of the Bridge. The Contractor will also furnish One Hundred lineal ft. of 3x6" yellow guard.

Plans are on file at Co. Clerk's Office. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check for Twenty five Dollars \$25⁰⁰ made payable to Gus H. Brune Chairman of the Board of Co. Commissioners. The right reserved to reject any or all bids.
