

June 20th 1913

The Board of Equalization met in adjourned session with all members present.

The Personal Property assessment of the American Cement and Plaster Co. was increased by \$12999 on account of Capital Stock which was omitted from assessment in Turkey Creek lot.

The request of Mrs J E Emery of May 27th 1913 to reduce the Assessment Valuation of a second Mortgage from \$3900 to \$1000 was granted.

Nature of same could not be obtained from Co. Commis.

Board ordered assessment on Grange Hall at Vinland to be stricken off the tax Roll property being exempt.

Board ordered Personal Property assessment of W. H. Smith reduced from \$1105 to \$295 on a/c of his claim that property was worthless hence should not be taxed.
