Board issued the following order: Copy
To the Sheriff of Douglas County.

You are hereby commanded to release from your custody, Cliff Thornton who is held by you for non-payment of his fine and costs in a case of the State of Kansas in the May term of District Court, in this County in the year 1913. His release is on condition that he pay to the County of Douglas the above named costs and fine within one year from this date. In default of this you are hereby commanded to take him again into custody in accordance with the terms of and by virtue of the original commitment.

Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for the consideration hereinafter mentioned, agrees to furnish all material, and to build and construct for the said party of the second part. Steel joist and Steel hand Railing and Velle guards with hook bolts, as per plan hereto attached. and have the same completed on or before the 21st day of December A D 1913
