Now, therefore, be it Resolved by said Board of County Commissioners, That if said proposition carries at said special election, that said Board will cause to be constructed across the Kaw River at Lawrence, Kansas, a reinforced concrete bridge above high water mark according to the best, approved, up to date plan obtainable at a price not to exceed \$200,000.
