Best grade of Cherokee Lump coal, for use of the Douglas County Home, on car on track at India Station near Lawrence, Kansas, at the rate of Three and 60/100 Dollars (\$3.60) per. ton; said coal to be delivered: One car load by October 1st, 1913 and one car load by November 1st, 1913; any further deliveries to be made whenever directed by the County Commissioners.
