Know all Men By these Presents, That H. D. Gwin, of Douglas County, Kansas, hereinafter called the principal, and H. E. Spalding and H. A. Gwin of Douglas County, Kansas as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in the principal sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) lawful money of the United States of America, to the payment of which well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our heirs, our executors, administrators and assigns, jointly and severally firmly by these presents, signed sealed and dated this 5th day of September, A. D. 1913.

Whereas the said principal has entered into a certain written contract bearing even date herewith, to furnish and deliver to the said Board of County Commissioners, certain coal, during the year beginning September 2nd, 1913 in quality and at times in said contract provided and at the prices therein mentioned;

Now, Therefore, the condition of the foregoing obligation is such that if the said H. D. Gwin, the principal, shall well, truly, and faithfully comply with all the terms, covenants and conditions of said contract on his part to be kept and performed according to its tenor, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
