on Lincoln Street, and all streets and alleys bordering
on or intersecting any and all of the aforesaid property,
be vacated and excluded from the boundaries of said
city of Baldwin City, Douglas County, Kansas, and that
said property so vacated and excluded shall be listed
for future taxation the same as though it had never
been a part of such city.

And it is further ordered by said Board of County
Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on this date
that the boundaries of said city of Baldwin City,
Kansas, be changed to conform to the territory
remaining in said city, after the vacation and
exclusion from said city of the hereinbefore mentioned
and described property.
