on King Street; Lots one (1) to twenty-one (21), ^{odd numbers} inclusive, on Lincoln Street; Lots two (2) to sixteen (16), ^{even numbers} inclusive on Lincoln Street, and all streets and alleys bordering on or intersecting any and all of the aforesaid property, be vacated and excluded from the boundaries of said city of Baldwin City, Douglas County, Kansas, and that said property, so vacated and excluded shall be listed for future taxation the same as though it had never been a part of such city.

And it is further ordered by said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on this date that the boundaries of said City of Baldwin City, Kansas, be changed to conform to the territory remaining in said city, after the vacation and exclusion from said city of the hereinbefore mentioned and described property.

The Board instructed the county clerk to deliver a copy of the above order to the Register of Deeds and to send a copy of same to the city clerk of Baldwin City.

The County Assessor assessed the 5 1/2 of Lots 7 & 11, Addition 11, North Lawrence at \$40 each and deducted the amount from the original valuation of Lots 7 & 11, North Lawrence and changed the description of said property to conform to this change in assessed value, by order of this Board.

The Board approved the coal contract Bonds of E. O. Karnes and W. B. Swin as shown on pages 535, 536 and 537 of this record.

The Board adjourned to September, 13, 1913.
