The following report by Surveyor Buffle, was submitted and approved: (Copy) November 29, 1913.

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas.

Gentlemen: I have the honor to report that I have inspected the work being done on the County road one half mile west of Decompton on the hill near Edgewood Park. The work is being done in a good and satisfactory manner, but there is not enough money left from the former appropriation to complete the job. I think it would be good economy to make a further appropriation and let the work go on rather than close it up and re-open it later. I would advise an appropriation of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) more for the work as I think that amount will be enough to carry the cut on through as it is now going.
