Commissioners and by the County Clerk, both principal and interest of this bond are payable to the Fiscal Agency of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeka, Kansas. And the said County is hereby held and firmly bound and the full faith and credit of said County are hereby pledged for the prompt payment of this bond and interest at maturity.

This bond is one of a series of fifty-two (52) bonds of like date and tenor, numbered from one (1) to fifty-two (52) inclusive, issued by said County for the purpose of refunding a like amount of the outstanding bonded indebtedness heretofore legally created by said County, and which has been outstanding over two (2) years. This bond is issued and executed under and by authority of and in accordance with an act of the Legislature of the State of Kansas entitled "An Act to enable Counties, Municipal corporations, boards of education of any city and school districts, to refund their indebtedness", which took effect March 10, 1879, and all amendments thereto. Also by virtue of a resolution duly and legally passed by the full Board of County Commissioners.

And it is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required to be done precedent to, and in the issuing of the series of bonds have been properly done, happened and performed in regular and due form as required by law and that the indebtedness which is refunded by this series of bonds is a constitutional, subsisting and legal obligation of said County and that neither the indebtedness so refunded nor this series of bonds exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.

In Witness Whereof, we, the undersigned officers of the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, being duly authorized to execute this obligation on its behalf, have hereunto set our official signatures and caused the seal of said County to be hereunto affixed this --- day of ---, 19---.
