

Tuesday, January 13, 1914.

Board met in regular adjourned session with all members present.

Claims against the County were examined and allowed as per allowance record.

County Engineer reported as follows:-

"On Jan. 12, 1914, I found the amount of material removed from the cut on the Pippert Hill to be 1600 cu yds which entitles Mr. King to payment for 1200 cu. yds.

In accordance with the above report the Board instructed the County Clerk to draw a warrant (No. 7091) for the amount (\$540.00)

Board refunded to Elizabeth Martin, Personal Property tax for the year 1913 in the amt of \$1.25, on ac of exemption allowed and instructed the County Clerk to draw a warrant for the amount.

Board instructed the County Clerk to authorize the Treasurer to allow Hm T. Sinclair to redeem Lots 165 and 166 West Lawrence for taxes assessed against said lots for the years 1875, 1876, 1877, and 1878 for the sum of \$6.34 plus Redemption fee of 55c; said Hm T. Sinclair having petitioned for such an order and this Board upon investigation having found that such order would be to the best interests of Douglas County.

Board ordered the County Clerk to instruct the Treasurer to cancel taxes for the year 1913 as follows:-
 \$41.95 of the tax on Lot 21 University Heights on ac of improvements on said lot having burned previous to Mar. 1, 1913.
 \$4.63 Personal property tax of Eva S. Samuels of Baldwin on ac of "No exemption allowed."
 \$3.42 Personal property tax of E. T. Harwood of Lawrence on ac of "double assessment"; the above cancellations being made on recommendation of the County Assessor and the State Tax Commission.

In the matter of a road petitioned for by J. J. Eddy and others (See page 556) this Board allowed same as petitioned for and instructed the County Clerk to notify Trustee of Hk. Township to open said road 25 feet in width, also allowed damages to Rose J. Latta of \$100.00 and instructed the County Clerk to draw a warrant for the amount.

Board appointed S. T. Gillispie as County Health Officer and H. H. Gillum as janitor for the coming year.
